

INFORMATIONAL: Cleveland Cuyahoga Port Authority

LEGISLATION

1. Ordinance No. 406-08 (Cimperman/Ward 13): Authorizing the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies to sell City-owned property no longer needed for public use located at 1150 east 38th Street, to the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation for the State's Innerbelt Project; and authorizing the Director of public Safety to lease back the property located at 1150 East 38th Street from the State of Ohio, for a limited term, for the public purpose of operating the Division of Police's mounted Unit. ***(Approved by CPC on 3/28/08)***
