MANDATORY REFERRALS

- Ord. No. 936-2024 (Introduced by Councilmember McCormack, Bishop and Hairston by departmental request) Authorizing the Director of Capital Projects to issue a permit to the Apartment 92, The Apollo, LLC to encroach into the public right-of-ways of Riverbed Street and Superior Avenue by installing, using and maintaining a new entry canopy, an egress steel stair landing, an ADA ramp and a Viaduct connector. This item is being postponed due to insufficient information.
- 2. Authorizing the Mayor and the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies to sell certain City-owned properties no longer needed fir the City's public use located on Brookpark



and Old Grayton Roads near the NASA Glenn Research Center to NASA Park, LLC for purposes if developing hotels and restaurants.

- 3. Authorizing the Director of Capital Projects to enter into one or more agreements with the Board of Park Commissioners of the Cleveland Metropolitan School District regarding a City contribution of funding to implement the Old Lorain Connector Trail; and authorizing the Director to accept the donation of a temporary easement from Metroparks for a period of ten years located within the project area for the purpose of implementing the project.
- 4. Determining that the establishment of the North Coast Waterfront New Community Authority will be conducive to the public safety, convenience, and welfare and is intended to result in the development of a new community and declaring the North Coast Waterfront New Community Authority to be organized and a body politic and corporate, and defining the boundary of the new community district; appointing members to the Board of Trustees to such authority and establishing related requirements; authorizing Intergovernmental Agreements; amending Sections 131.78, 455.09, and 455.10 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended, relating to parking fees, and declaring an emergency.
