No. 1416-2025** (introduced by Council Members Polensek, Bishop, and Griffin by departmental request) To amend Sections 2 and 11 of Ordinance No. 993-2025, passed August 13, 2025, relating to agreements with Cuyahoga County and Cleveland Metroparks for the Euclid Beach Trail Connector to add additional land to the submerged land lease; and to supplement the ordinance by adding new Sections 11a, 11b, 11c, 11d, and 11e relating to subleasing the land to the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District.
- 4. **Ord. No. 1417–2025** (introduced by Council Members Hairston and Griffin by departmental request) Approving certain modifications and amendments to the St. Vincent Center (Project No. Ohio R-13) Urban Renewal Plan with respect to releasing a permanent parcel from the area boundaries.
- 5. **Ord. No. 1440–2025** (introduced by Council Members Welch, Hairston, and Griffin by departmental request) Approving the addition of property located at 1301 E. 9th Street to the Northeast Ohio Advanced Energy District; accepting and approving a petition and plan from a property owner in the District identifying a special energy improvement project; declaring it necessary to conduct the special energy improvement project; providing for the assessment of the cost of such special energy improvement project;

- authorizing the Director of Economic Development to enter into an Energy Project Cooperative Agreement and a Special Assessment Agreement to implement the project; and declaring an emergency.

No. 1446-2025** (introduced by Council Members Bishop and Griffin by departmental request) Determining the method of making the public improvements of purchasing, repairing, constructing, and installing signal support poles and authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into one or more public improvement requirement contracts for the making of the improvement, for a period not to exceed two years.
