Biography:

Ora Coltman was a well known Cleveland artist born in Shelby, Ohio who was also a draftsman and an attorney. He was a member of the A.S.L. of New York, and a member of the Water Color Society of Cleveland. He lived on Mayfield Road in Little Italy, where Coltman Road was named after him.
