Birth/Established: May 1, 1882 **Death/Dissolved:** June 21, 1942

Biography:

Theo Conner was born in Ireland and raised in Ontario. He was active in the architectural profession beginning in 1904. Charles Schweinfurth employed him where he was a designer of Trinity Cathedral. He later established his own office and is listed in the Cleveland City Directories from 1908 until 1939 as an architect. He was an enthusiastic hockey fan, who had some responsibility for bringing professional hockey to Cleveland, with a team in the International League.
