Biography:

F. Stillman Fish attended parochial schools in Cleveland and went to St. Ignatius College. In 1902, he went to work as a draftsman in the office of Searles and Hirsh and, three years later, went to work for Steffens and Steffens. In 1908 he went to Columbia University to pursue studies in architecture. This was followed by four years in the New York branch of the Beaux Arts Society. After completion of studies he was associated with the firms of Grosvenor Atterbury, Ernest Greene, Reed & Stem, and Woodruff Leeming. After returning to Cleveland he was associated with Charles Schneider and William Lougee. He was a member of the Beaux-Arts Society of New York and the Knights of Columbus. He lived at 2945 Corydon Road in Cleveland Heights. He is listed as a registered architect in the November 1940 issue of Ohio Architect. He retired in 1952.
