Biography:

Emile Uhlrich was born in Epinal, France. He was educated at the Ecole Fenelon, the Lycee St. Nicholas, and the Ecole des Beaux Arts. He came to the United States in 1891 at the age of eighteen. He was active as an architect in Cleveland from 1898 to 1923. In 1900 he was a lodger in the Charles Stanley Residence, 2150 East 22nd Street. He was naturalized on January 23, 1900. Initially he was a partner with Godfrey Fugman from 1899 to 1903 and then formed a short-lived partnership with Harry Cone in 1905. He left Cleveland after 1923. He would later live in the Hotel Maryland in New York City. He died in France and is buried in Cemetery of Villefranche near the Mediterranean.
