Charles Bates

Birth/Established: December 7, 1879 **Death/Dissolved:** November 28, 1931

Biography:

Charles Bates was a Wheeling, West Virginia-based architect with a Cleveland office. He was a native of Wheeling, attended Wheeling public schools, the Linly Military Institute, and studied architecture at the Armour Institute of Technology in Chicago. He began practicing architecture in 1904, working in both Chicago and Pittsburgh. He established a Wheeling office in 1909, later opening offices in Cleveland and Youngstown. He designed several of the Shaker Heights city schools. He was architect and construction engineer for scores of high schools in Ohio and West Virginia.
