Biography:

J. W. Hradek was Bohemian-born and came to Cleveland in 1882 where he studied architecture. He was employed by Andrew Mitermiller for five years and Lehman and Schmitt for three years. In 1890, he went into business for himself. He was a member of the Knights of Pythias of the Uniformed Rank and a member of the International Order of Odd Fellows. He lived at 6603 Consul Avenue. He died on August 23, 1936. His funeral was held at A. Nosek and Sons Funeral Home on East 55th Street.
