Henry Hradilek was born in Moravia, Austria-Hungary of Bohemian ancestors. He designed numerous single family homes in Cleveland Heights. In 1930, he was living at 24763 Lake Road in Bay Village. He died at the U. S. Marine Hospital after a long illness. He is buried in Lakewood Park Cemetery.
