Biography:

Ernest Huberty worked as a draftsman for Lehman & Schmitt in 1895. He was listed as a draftsman from 1897 to 1904 in Cleveland City Directories and as an architect from 1905 to the 1955 Cleveland City Directory. He was a registered architect according to the Ohio Architect November 1940 listing. He was a member of the firm of Huberty, Summerell & Gilman in 1911 and a partner with George S. Summerell in 1912. He lived at 8017 Whitethorn Avenue in the Hough neighborhood for most of his life.
