Biography:

This architectural firm was formed by Abram Garfield, George Harris, Alexander Robinson, and Gilbert P. Schafer. It was formed in 1935 and existed under this name until Abram Garfield's death in 1958. The firm, which still exists, is now known as Westlake, Reed, Leskosky Architects, and they celebrated their one hundredth anniversary in 2005.
