

Cleveland Architects

William H Dunn

Birth/Established: 1841 **Death/Dissolved:** March 31, 1906

Biography:

William H. Dunn was the architect of several important religious buildings. He is also noted for his work for the Cleveland Board of Education. He served the Union in the Civil War as a private with 15th Regiment of the Ohio Infantry, Company K. He worked in the office of Levi T. Scofield for seventeen years. He designed St. Stanislaus Church in 1886, the Convent of the Good Shepherd, St. Wendelin Church, and St. Mary's Church in Lorain. He was the City building inspector under Mayors Babcock (1887-8) and Gardner (1885-1886, 1889 - 1891). He was also superintendent of school buildings and was responsible for Cleveland Public Schools from 1884 to 1894. He boarded on Quincy Avenue in 1900 and was never married. He owned one sixth of the Fulton Tool Company. He died March 31, 1906 and is buried in Calvary Cemetery.
