Biography:

John H. Graham was born in Waynesburg, Pennsylvania and received a B. A. and an M. A. in Architecture from Cornell University. He was married to Jessie Orton in 1910. He was listed as an architect beginning in the 1916 Cleveland City Directory. He was a member of the Chamber of Commerce, the Athletic Club, the Lakewood Elks Club and Acacia County Club. In 1927 his office was located at 1610 Euclid Avenue and he lived at 3025 Fairfax in Cleveland Heights.
