

Sample Fence Site Plan








- 1 North Arrow

- 6 Dimensioned Fence Location (including measurements from all property lines, driveways, streets, structures on or adjacent to the property)










Sight Line Example (§ 358.03 of the Cleveland Zoning Code)

Fences must allow for proper sight lines. Any fence that is parallel to a driveway must meet the following restrictions within 15' of the driveway/road or driveway/sidewalk intersection:

- Not taller than 2.5 feet in height, unless all portions of the fence above 2.5 feet in height are at least 75% open (25% opacity)



--- = 4' ornamental fence, 25% opacity
