Harry A Cone

Birth/Established: February 12, 1880 **Death/Dissolved:** February 7, 1971

Biography:

Harry A. Cone was listed as an architect in Cleveland City Directories from 1905 to 1922. He developed a large Jewish clientele and was the architect of B' Nai Jeshurun Temple (now Shiloh Baptist Church), Mt. Sinai Hospital on East 37th Street, the Synagogue at Woodland and Kennard, and Sherrah Terrah Synagogue in Canton. He also designed a number of homes and commercial buildings. After 1922 he became Vice President of the Representative Construction Company. He also designed numerous residential, commercial and industrial buildings. He retired to Miami Beach, Florida in 1943 where he died in 1971.
